The purpose of the Preservation of the Native Flora of Florida law, Section 581.185 of the Florida Statutes and Rule Chapter 5B-40, is to prevent the wanton destruction of native plants and to encourage propagation and salvage of plants being destroyed through property development, and to facilitate the collection of regulated plant specimens for research purposes. Those persons wishing to deal in endangered or commercially exploited plants are encouraged to harvest plants from areas that are being cleared for highways, farming, reforestation, or development. Propagation of protected plant species is encouraged.
